

# OVARIAN CASE STUDY



## **Presenting Complaint**

43 year old female with constant dull ache, pressure in the pelvis and vulval varicities.

## **Diagnosis**

Abdominal and Pelvic ultrasound demonstrates left ovarian vein reflux and dilated veins in the pelvis.

## **Management**

Left ovarian vein embolisation under local anaesthetic using MRI compatible coils. Patient home same day.

## **Follow-up**

6-12 month pelvic ultrasound shows no dilated veins in the pelvis and patient remains asymptomatic.
